

AJR Next Generations Survey

As of 07/04/2021 we have had 489 responses to our survey.

At the time of taking the survey, 54.32% of respondents were members of AJR.

Of those who were not members, 42.7% did not realise that the AJR was also for the second generation.

The areas that most respondents were 'very interested' in were:

The areas that most respondents were 'not at all interested' in were:

1. Public speaking advice
2. Emotional support
3. Financial support
4. Volunteer opportunities
5. Legacy pack

86.7% of respondents who were not currently members of AJR said they would be encouraged to join if some of the listed opportunities were offered.

53.02% of the respondents live in Greater London, and 14.54% in the South-East.

48.12% of the respondents are aged 66-80, 42.26% are aged 51-65.
